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## A Note About the Statistics in This Document

With the exception of voter registration data on page 29, the statistical information displayed in this document was extracted from the United States Bureau of the Census's *2019–2023 5-Year American Community Survey (ACS)*, which became available on December 12, 2024. The ACS provides estimates of demographic, economic, housing, and social characteristics for numerous geographies every year, including five-year period estimates that describe the characteristics of an area over a specific period of time rather than for a specific point in time. Therefore, these data may not be comparable with point-in-time estimates. In this document, we have used estimates that the Bureau of the Census compiled at the legislative district and State levels for Nevada, as well as corresponding national data. 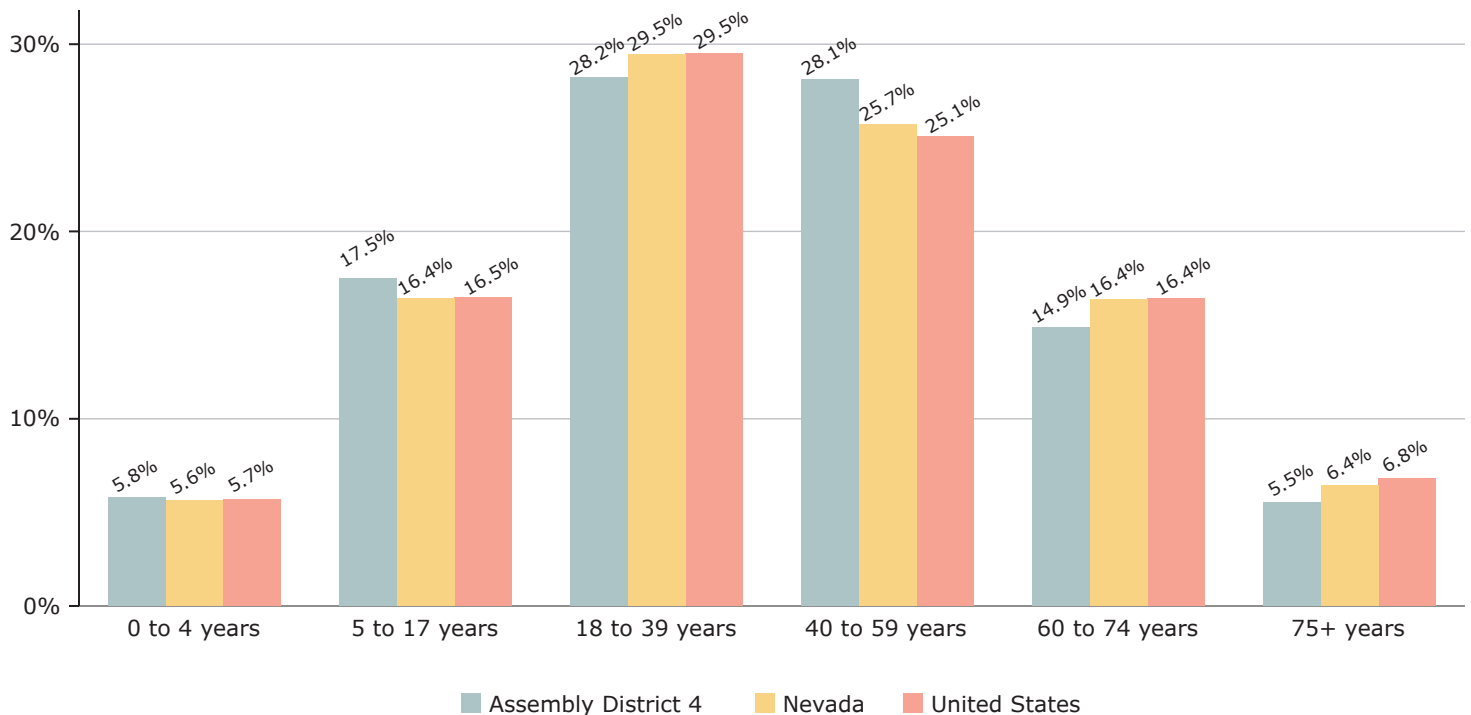

Chart 1—Population Distribution by Age

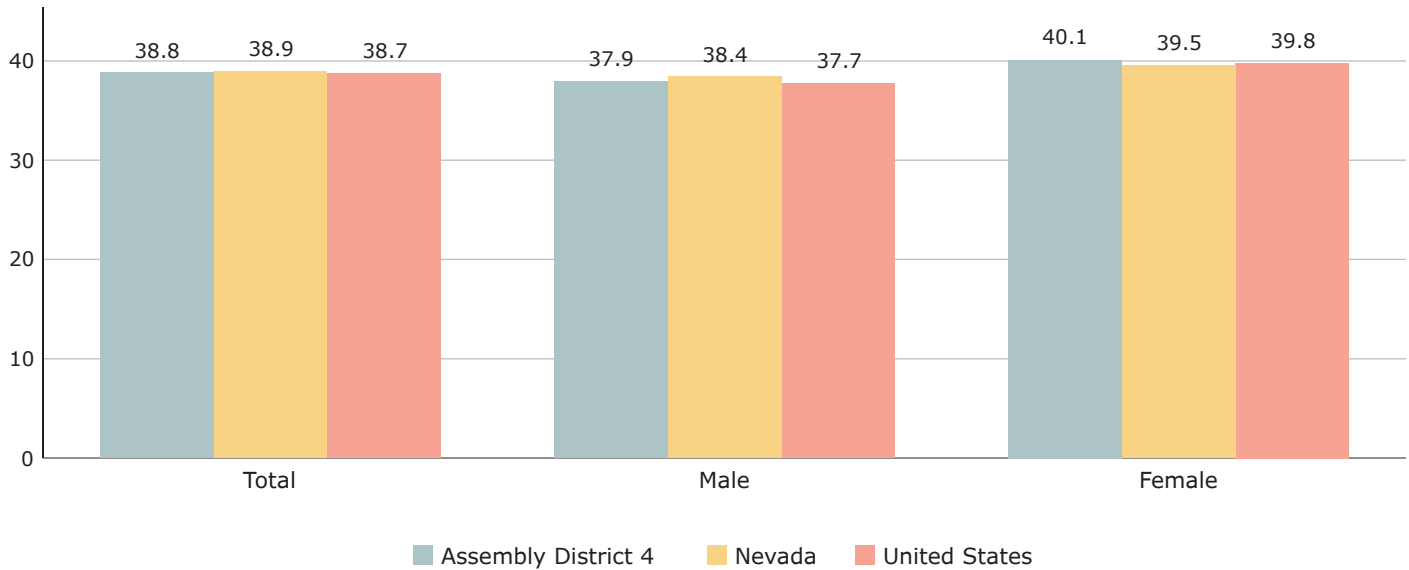

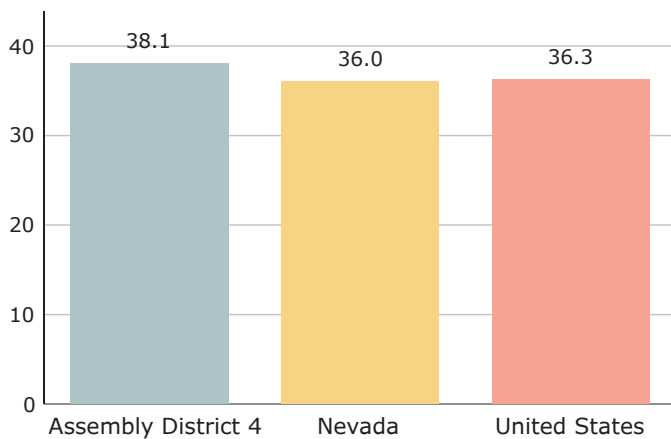

Chart 2—Median Age (in years)\*



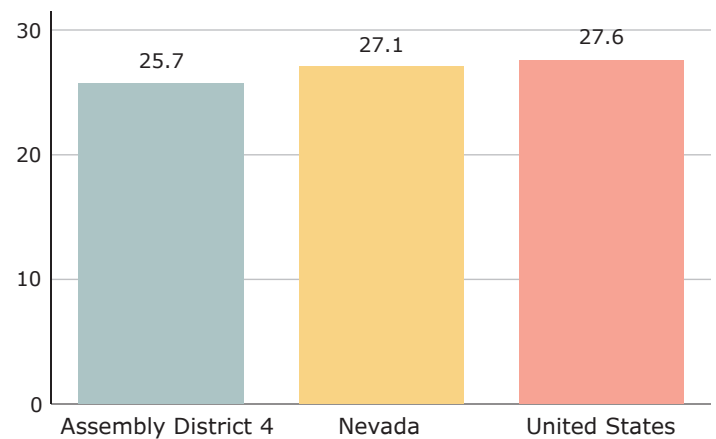

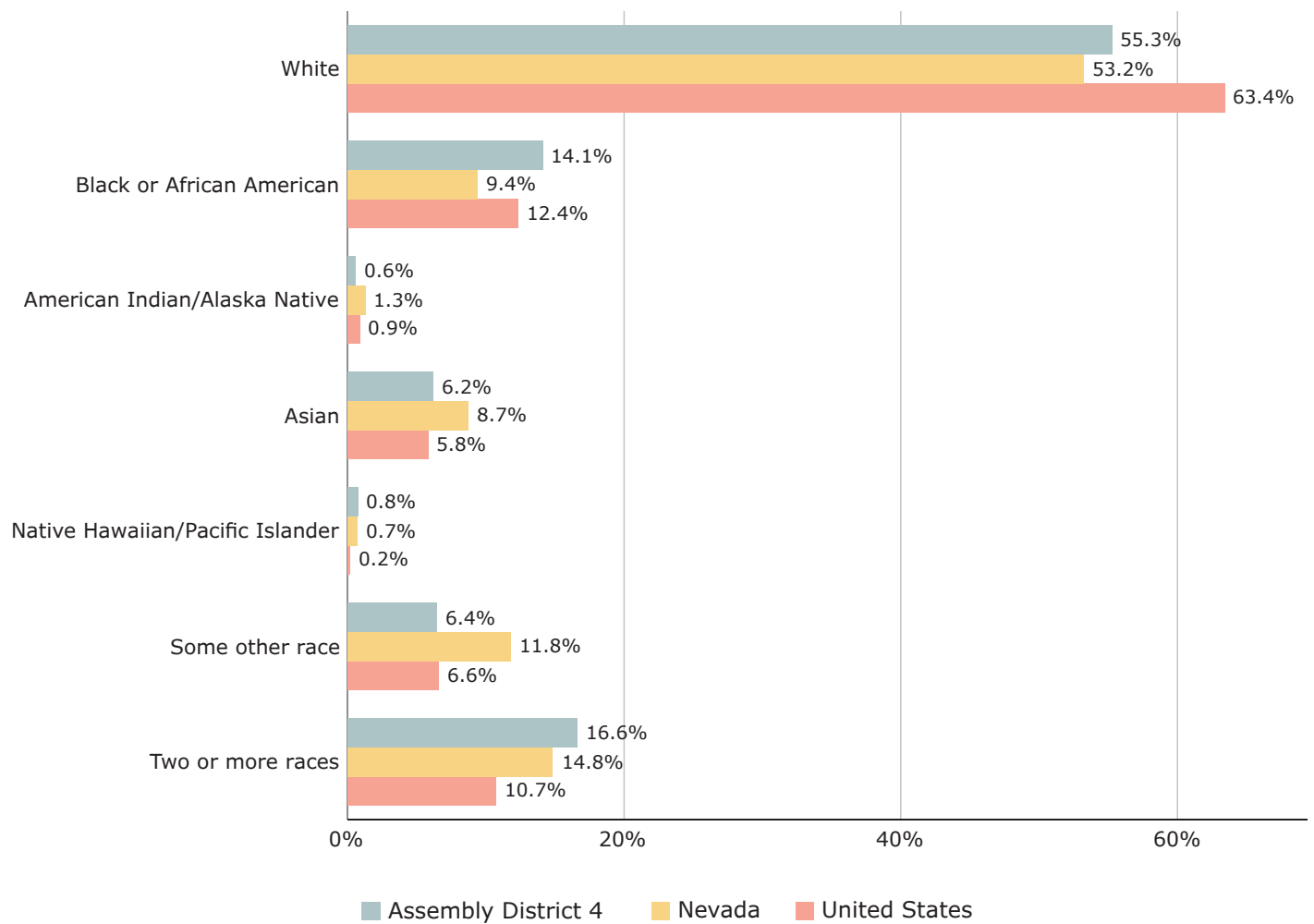

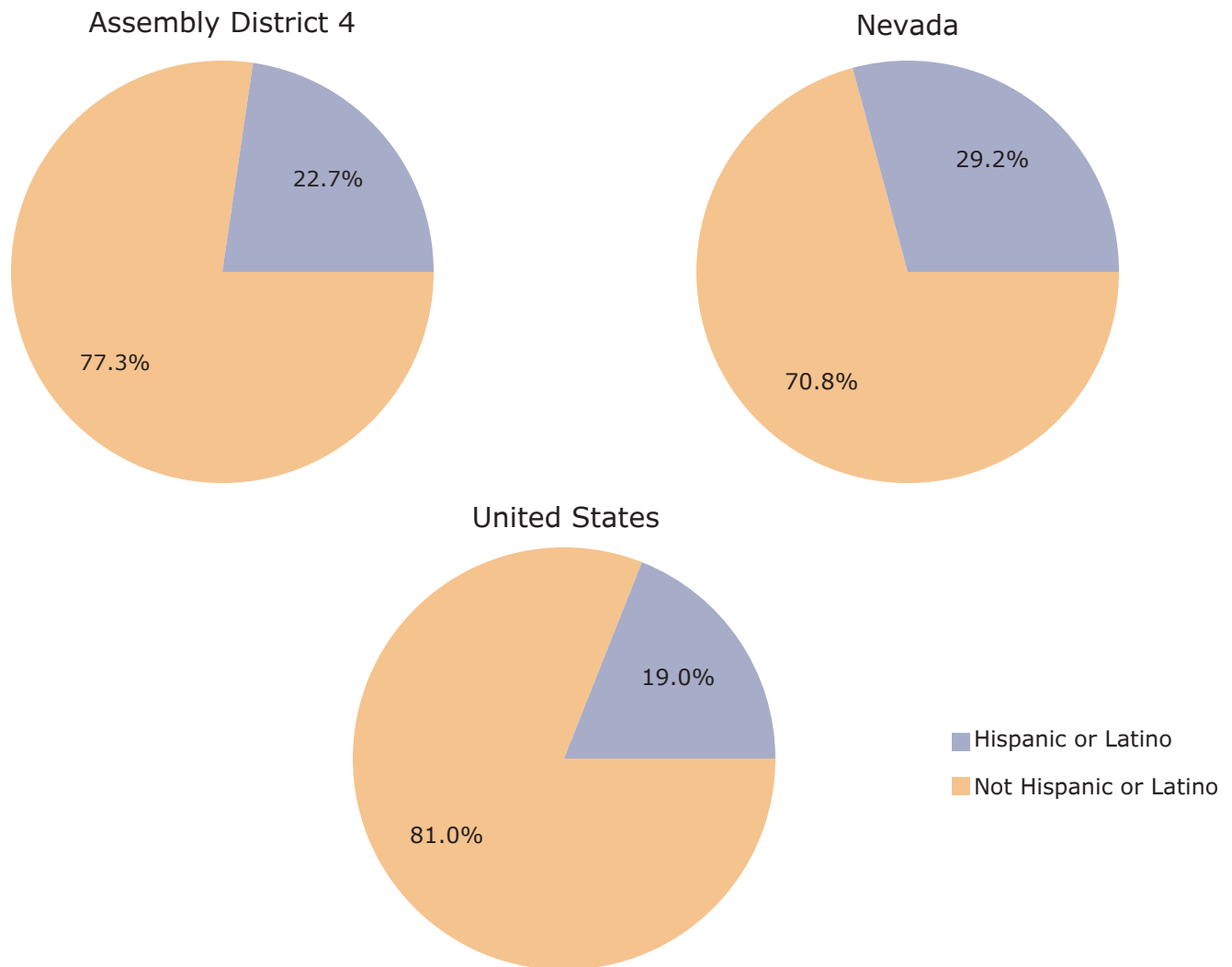

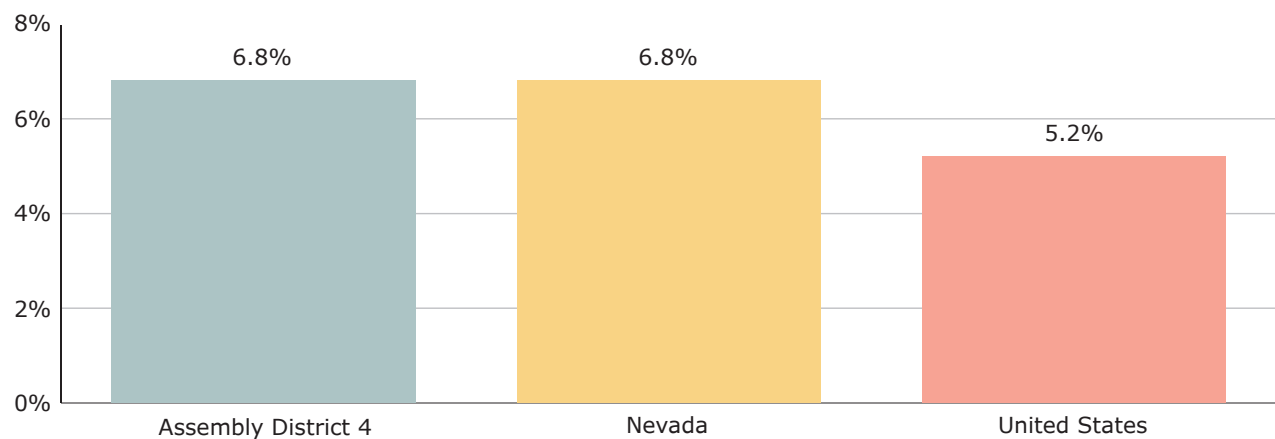

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Chart 8—Labor Force Participation Rate\*

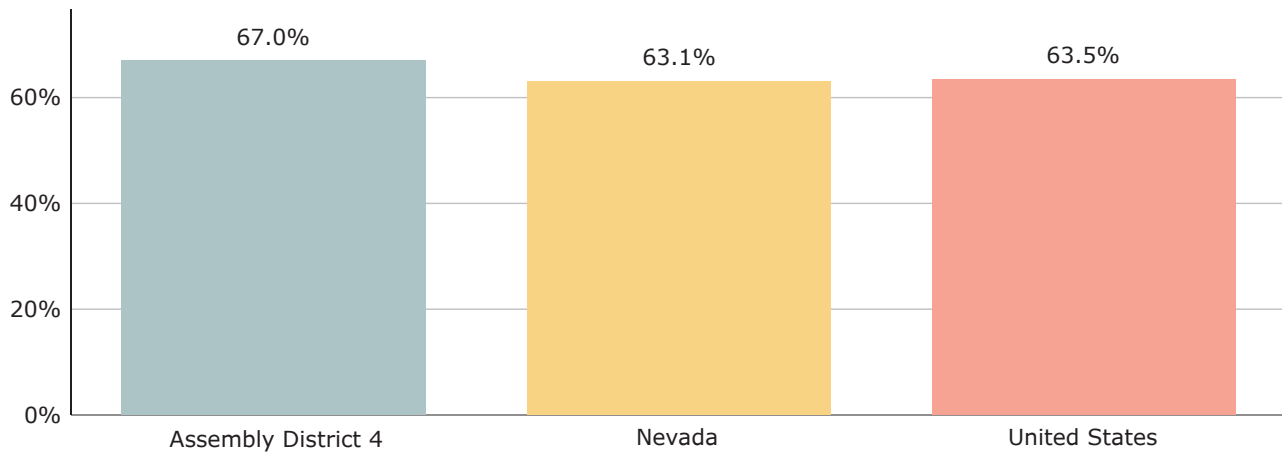
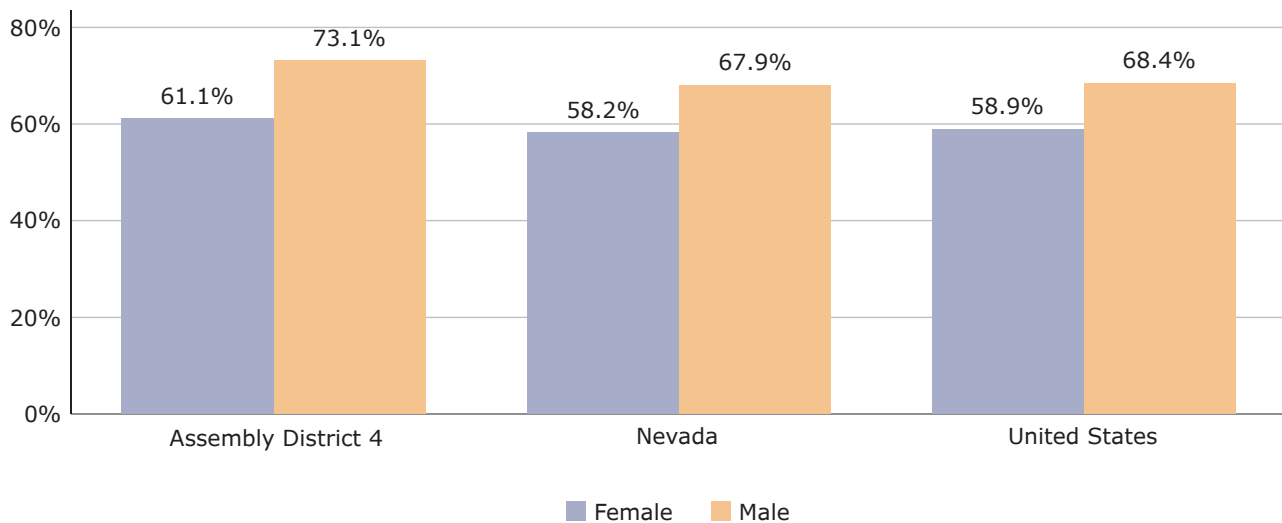


Chart 9—Labor Force Participation Rate\* by Gender

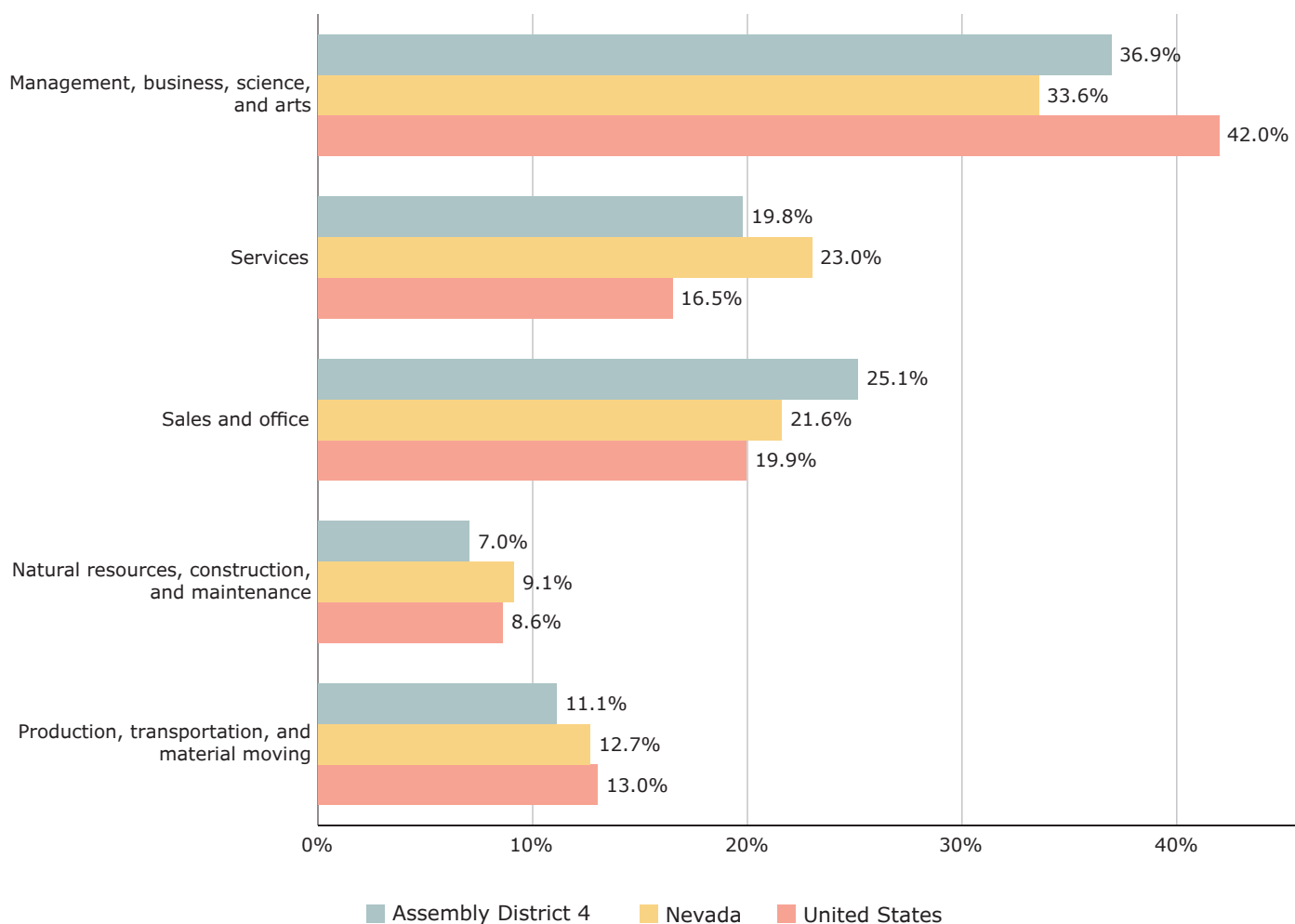

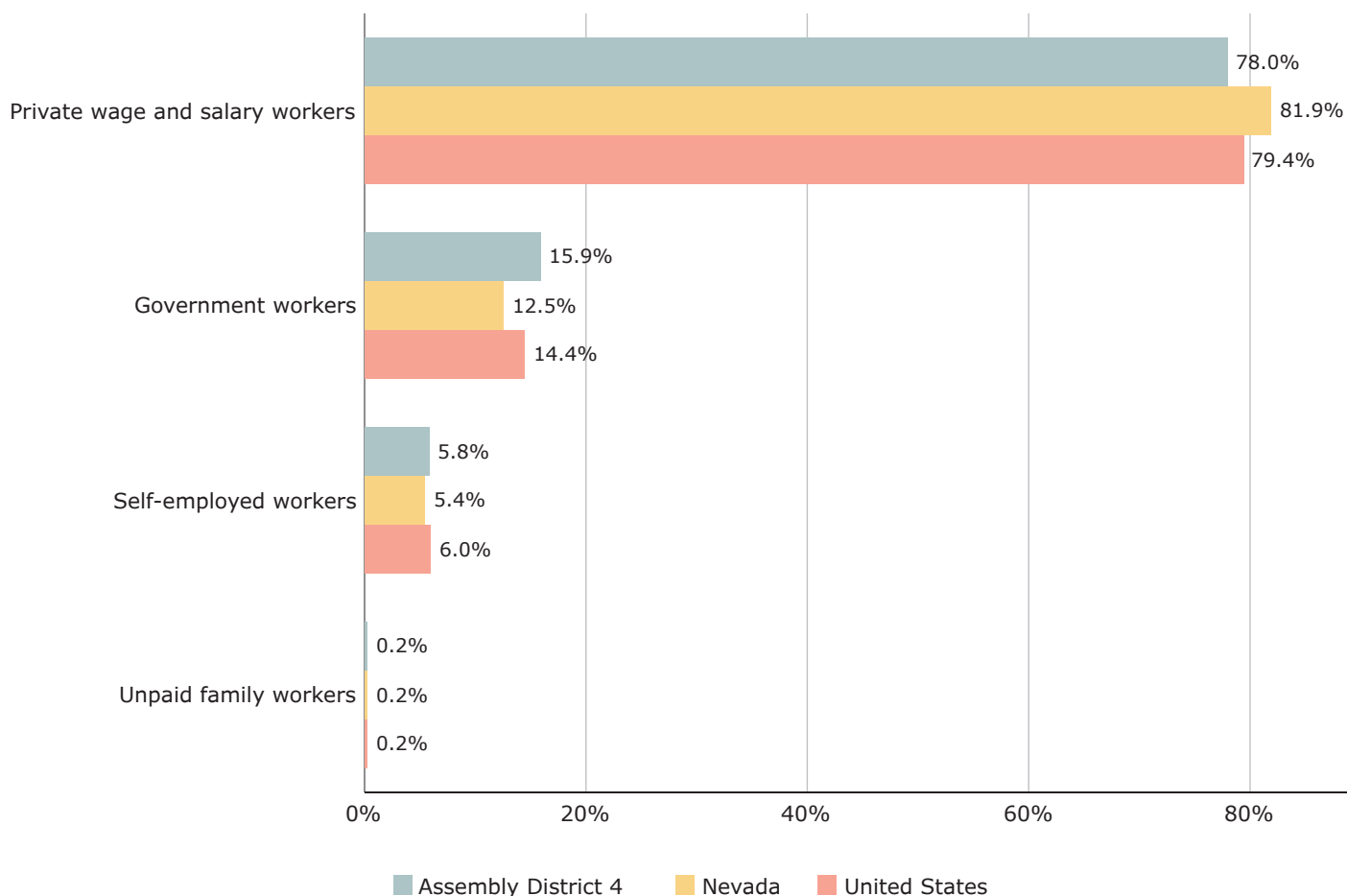

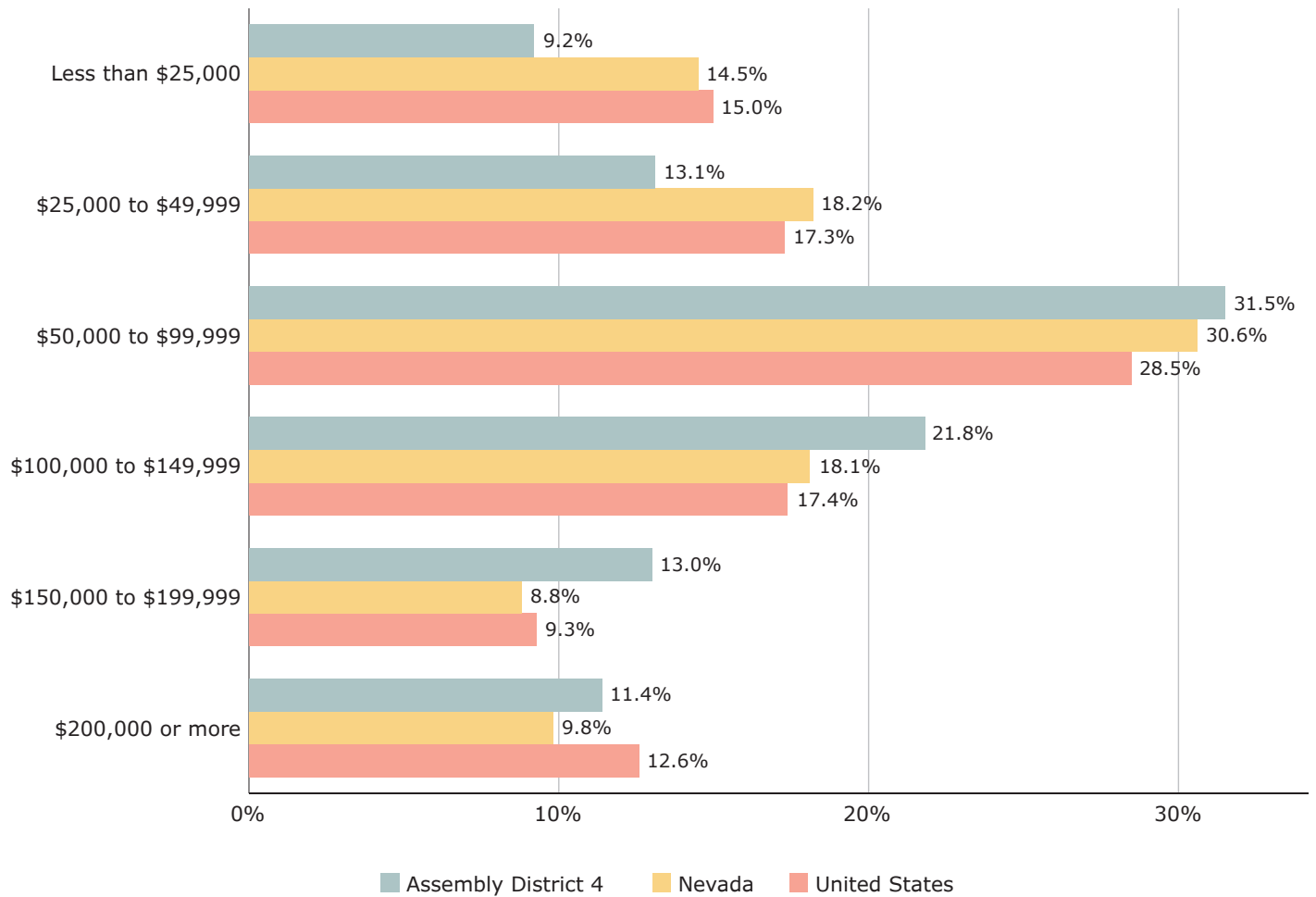

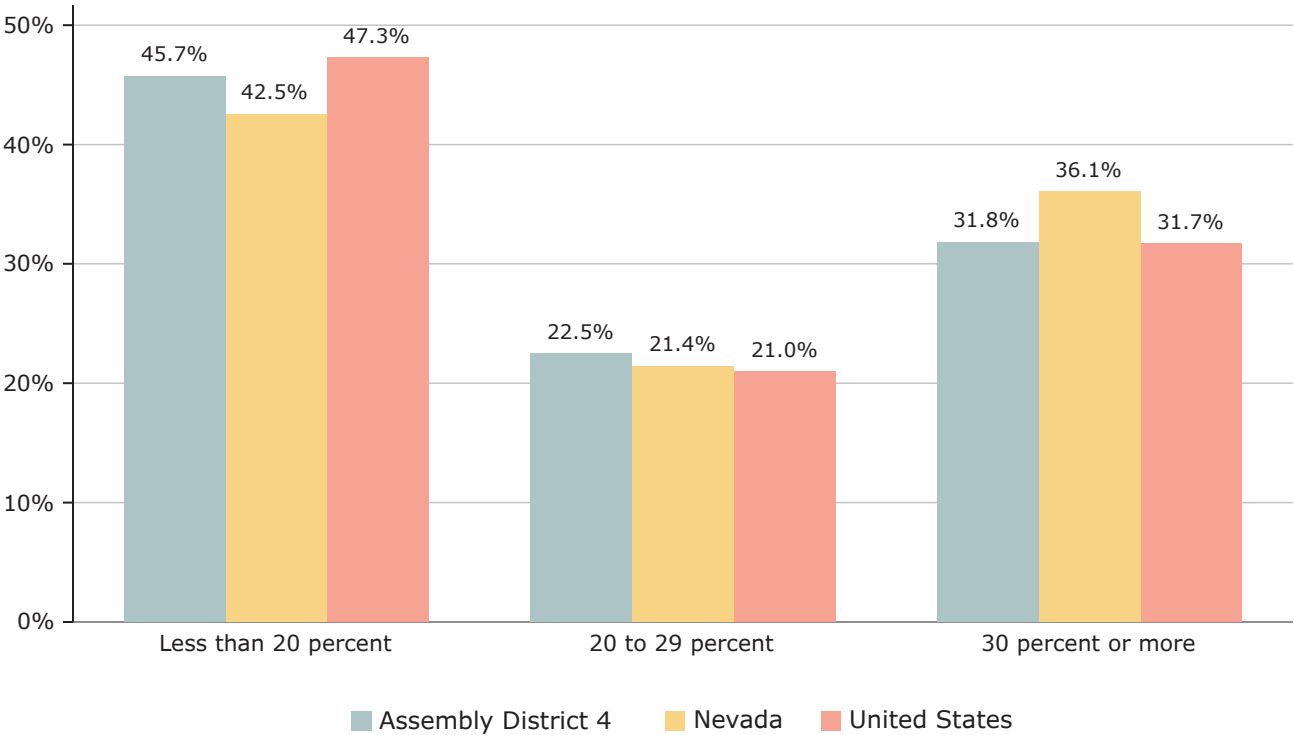

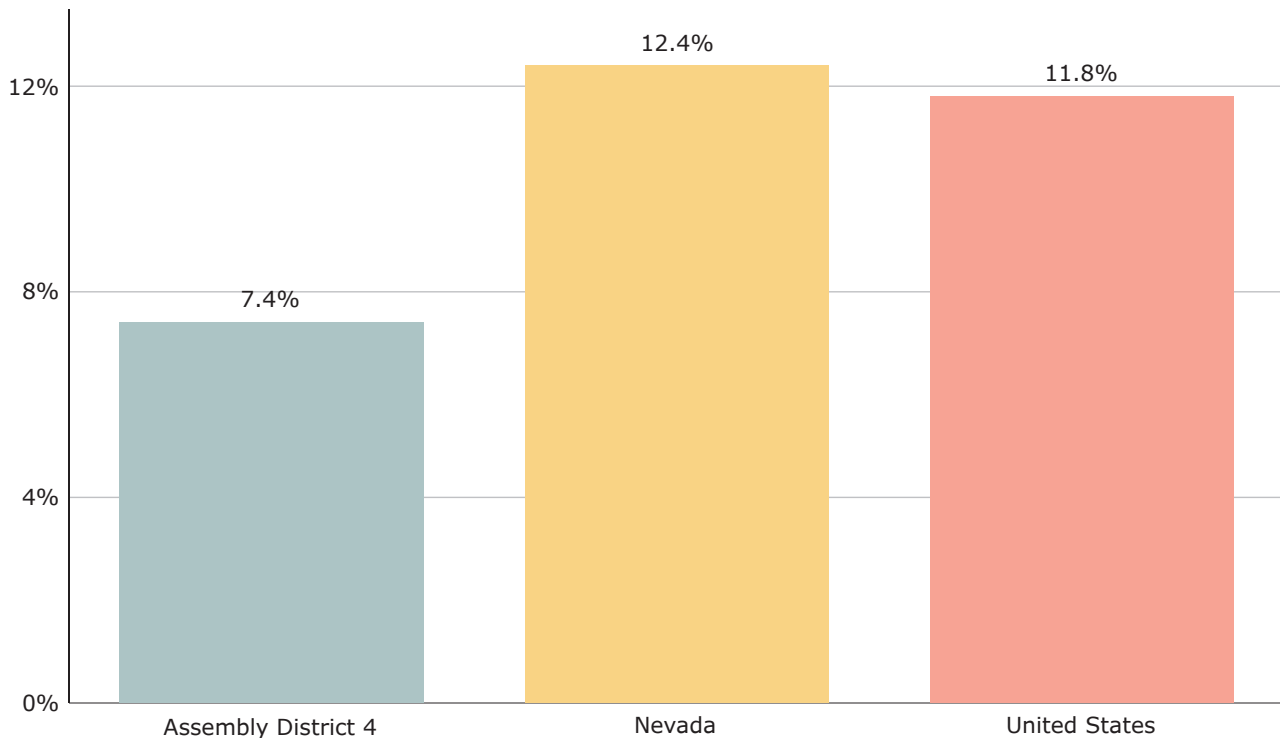

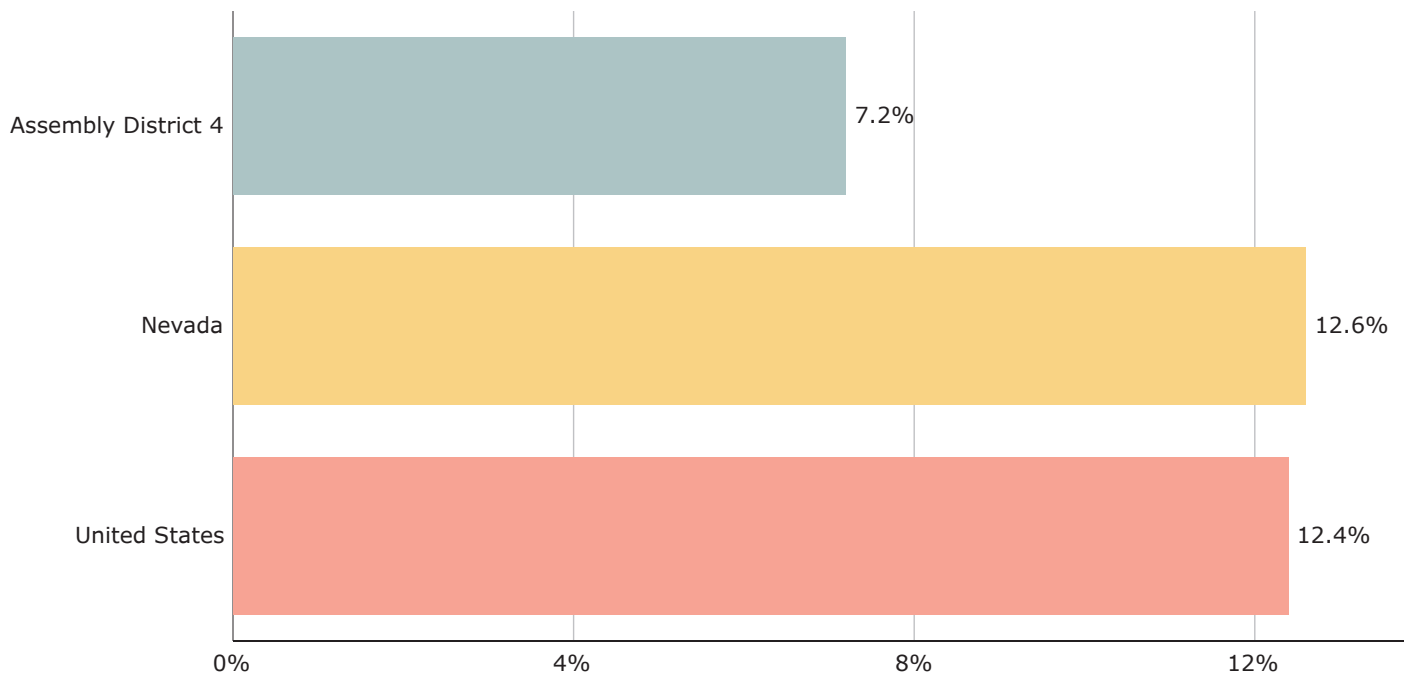

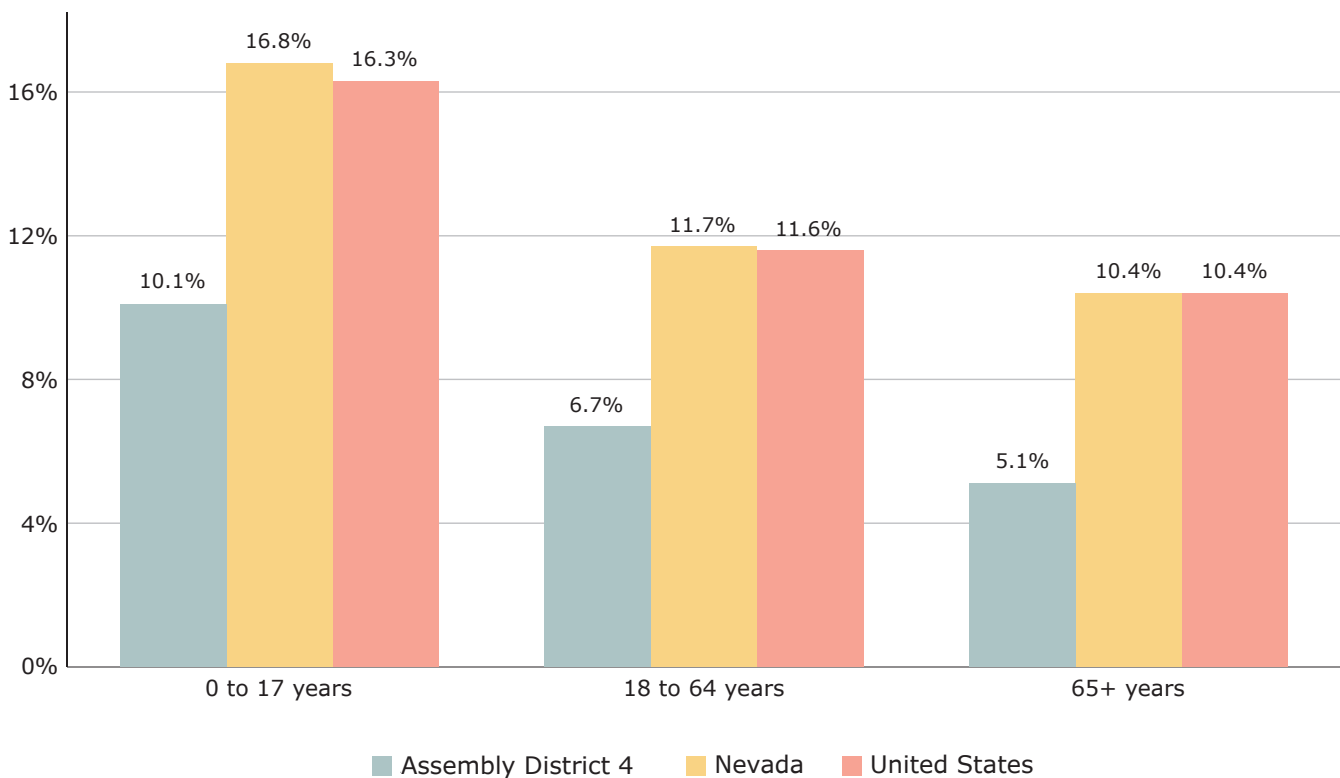

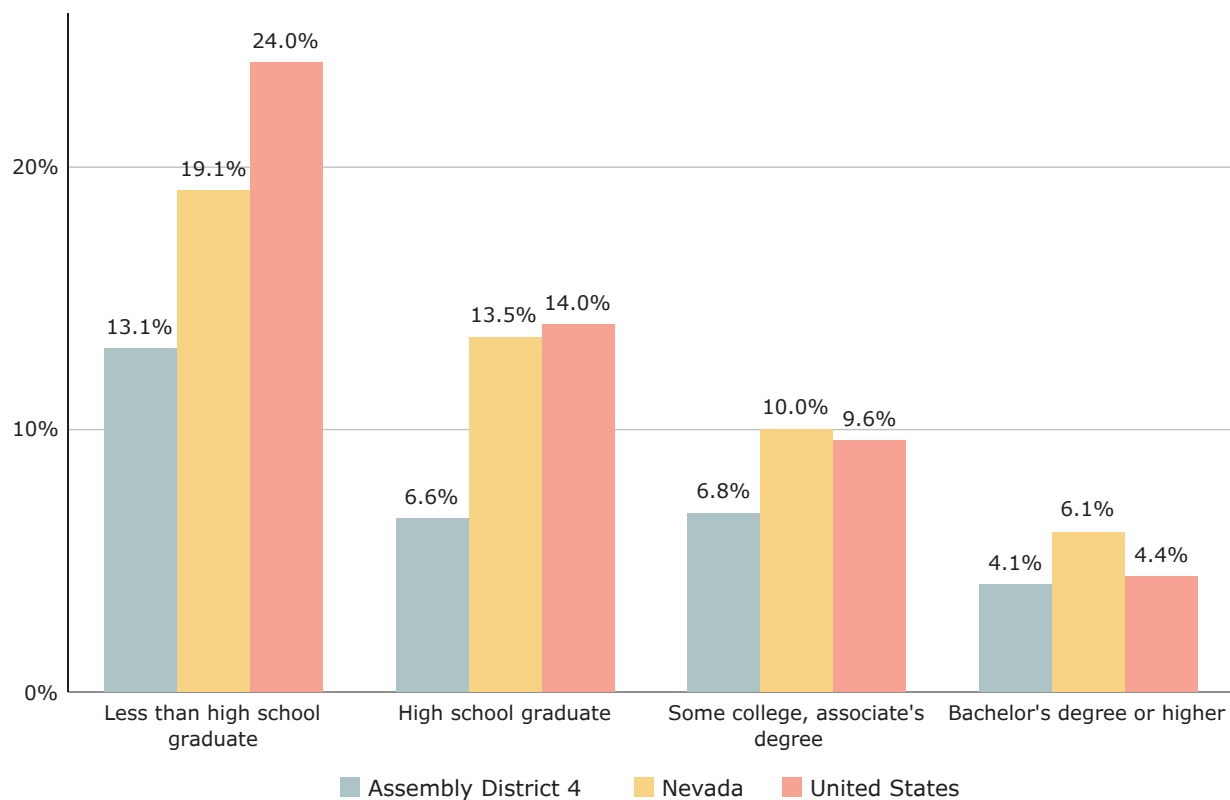

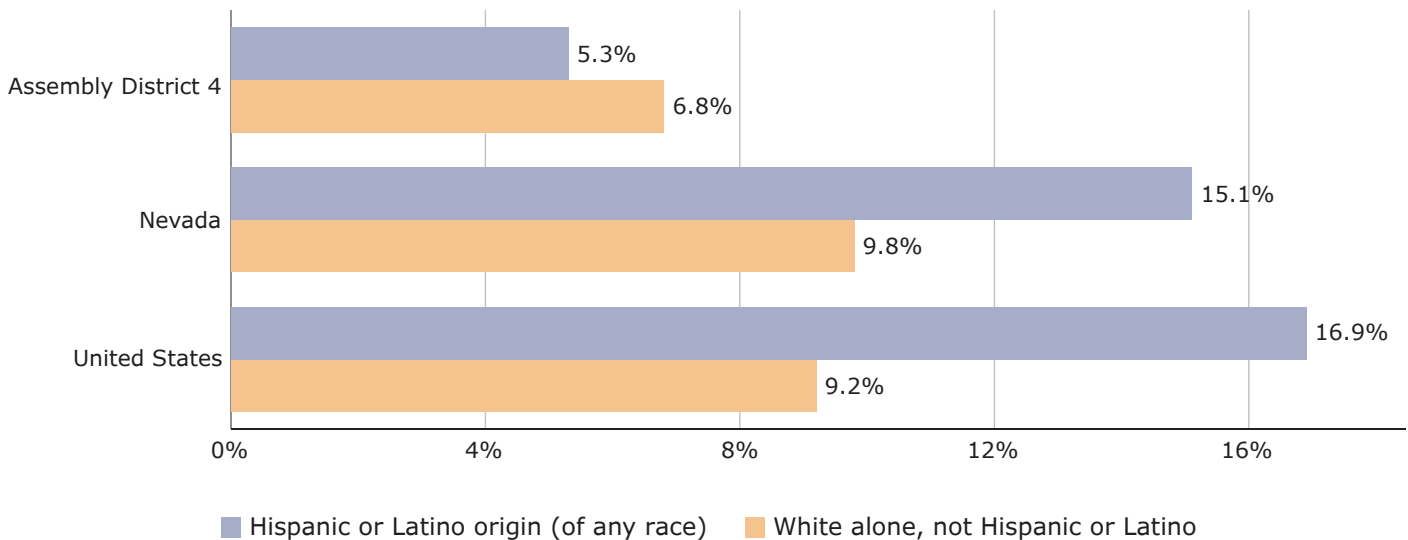

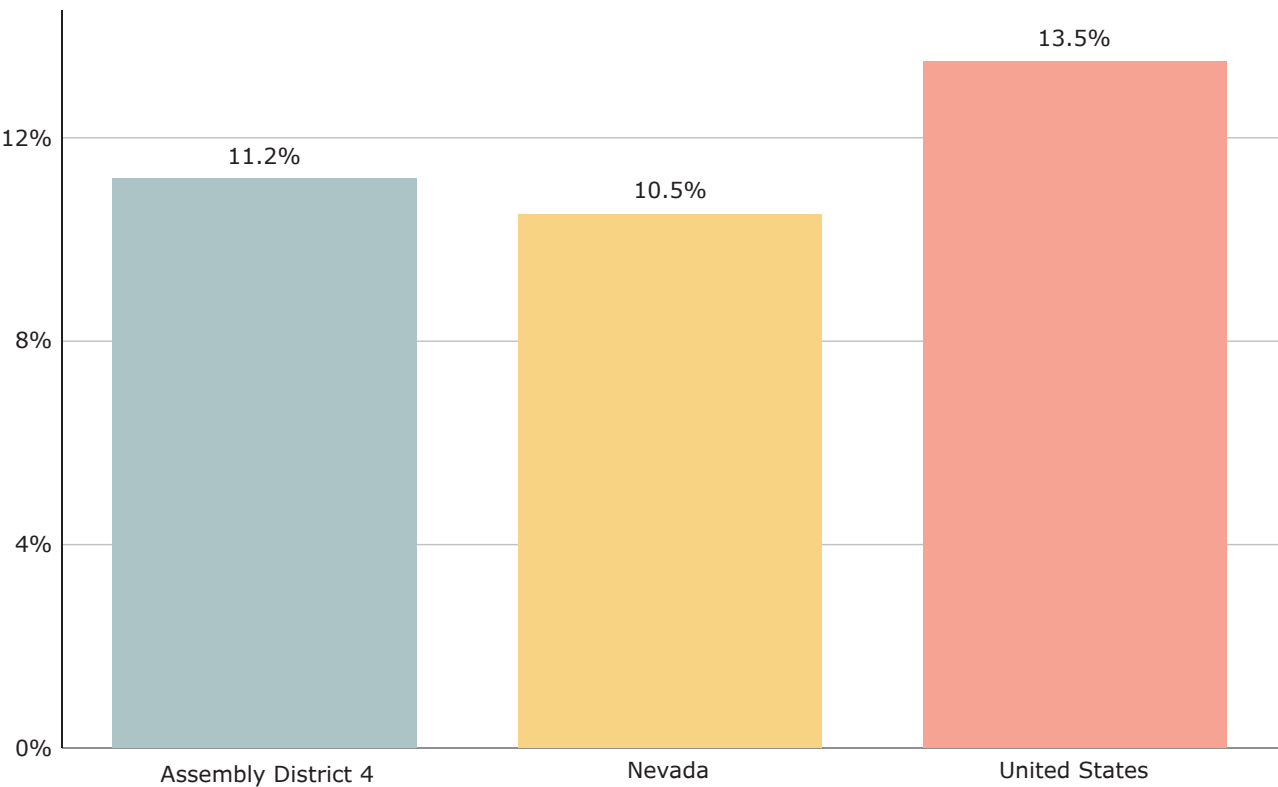

Chart 20—Methods of Travel to Work

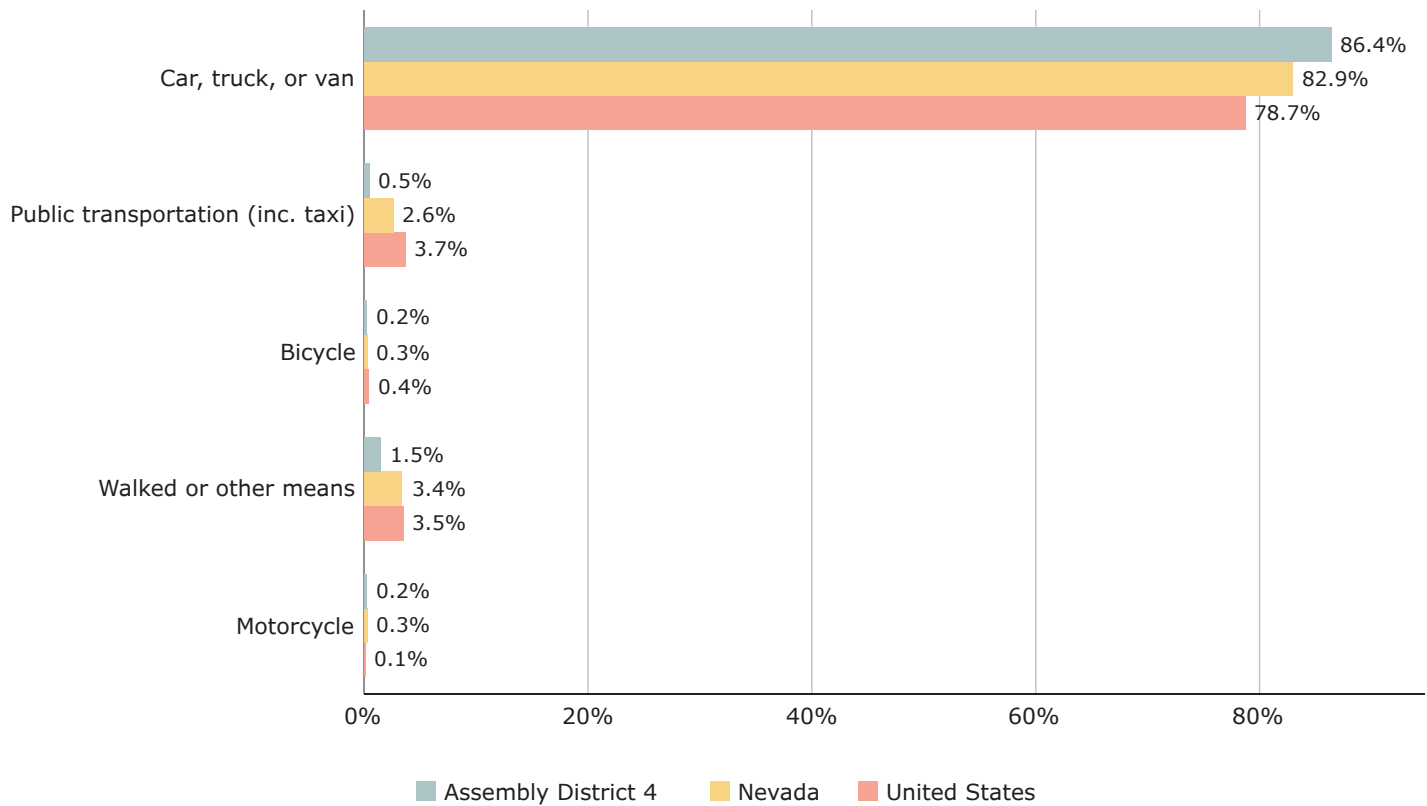
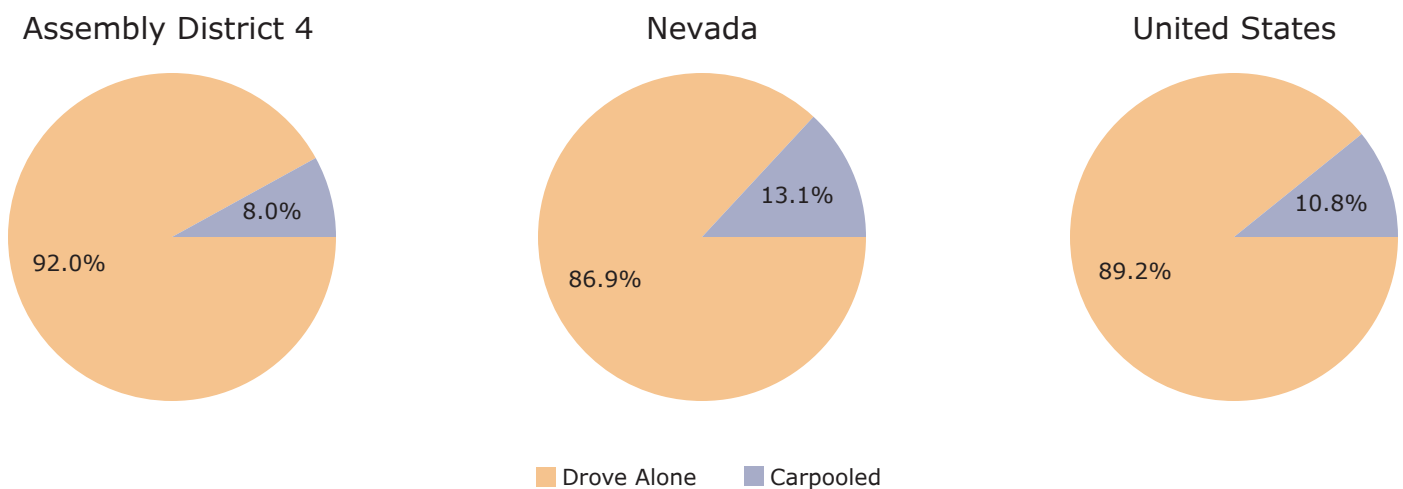


Chart 21—Percentage of Car, Truck, or Van Commuters Who Drove Alone Versus Carpooled

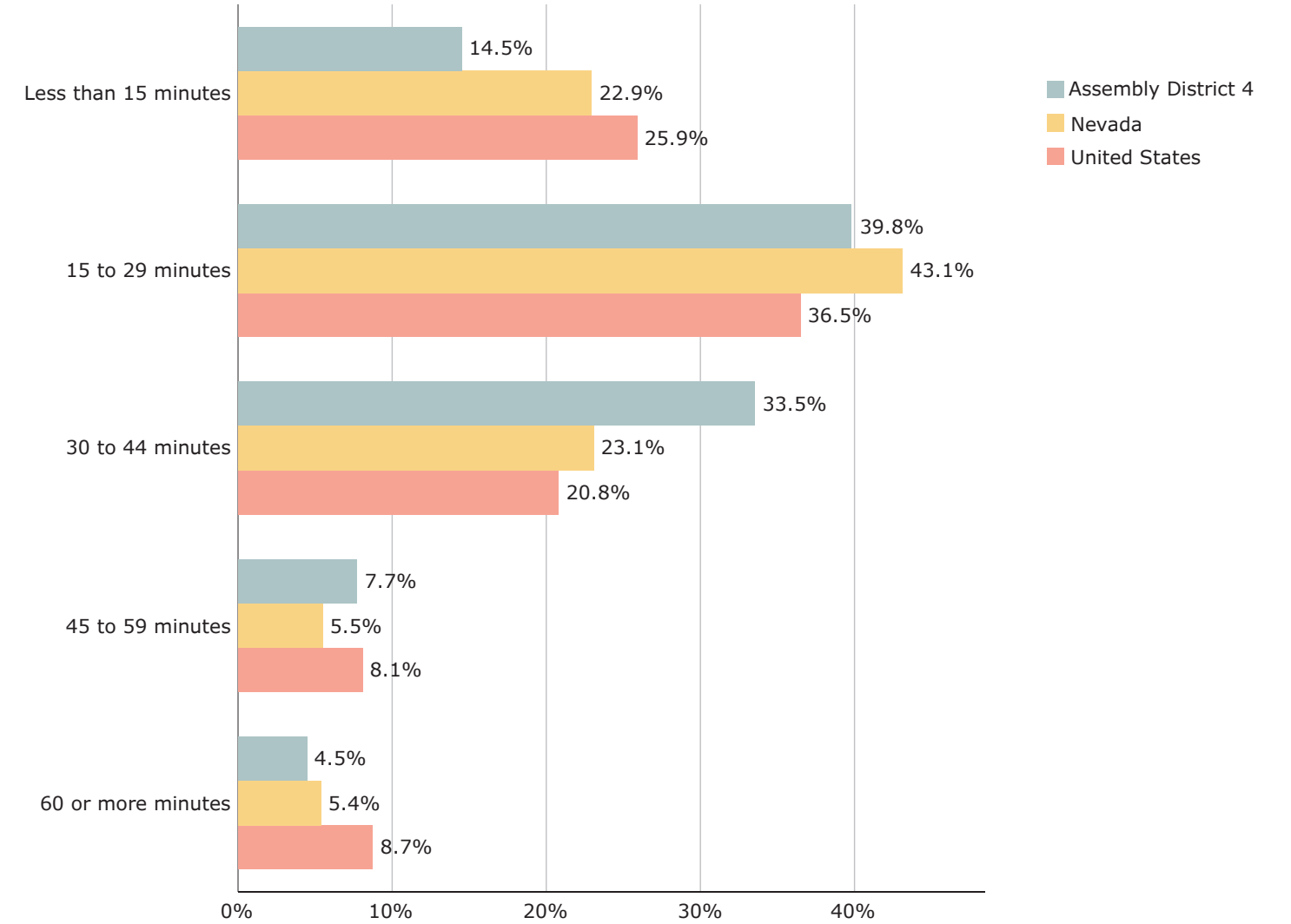

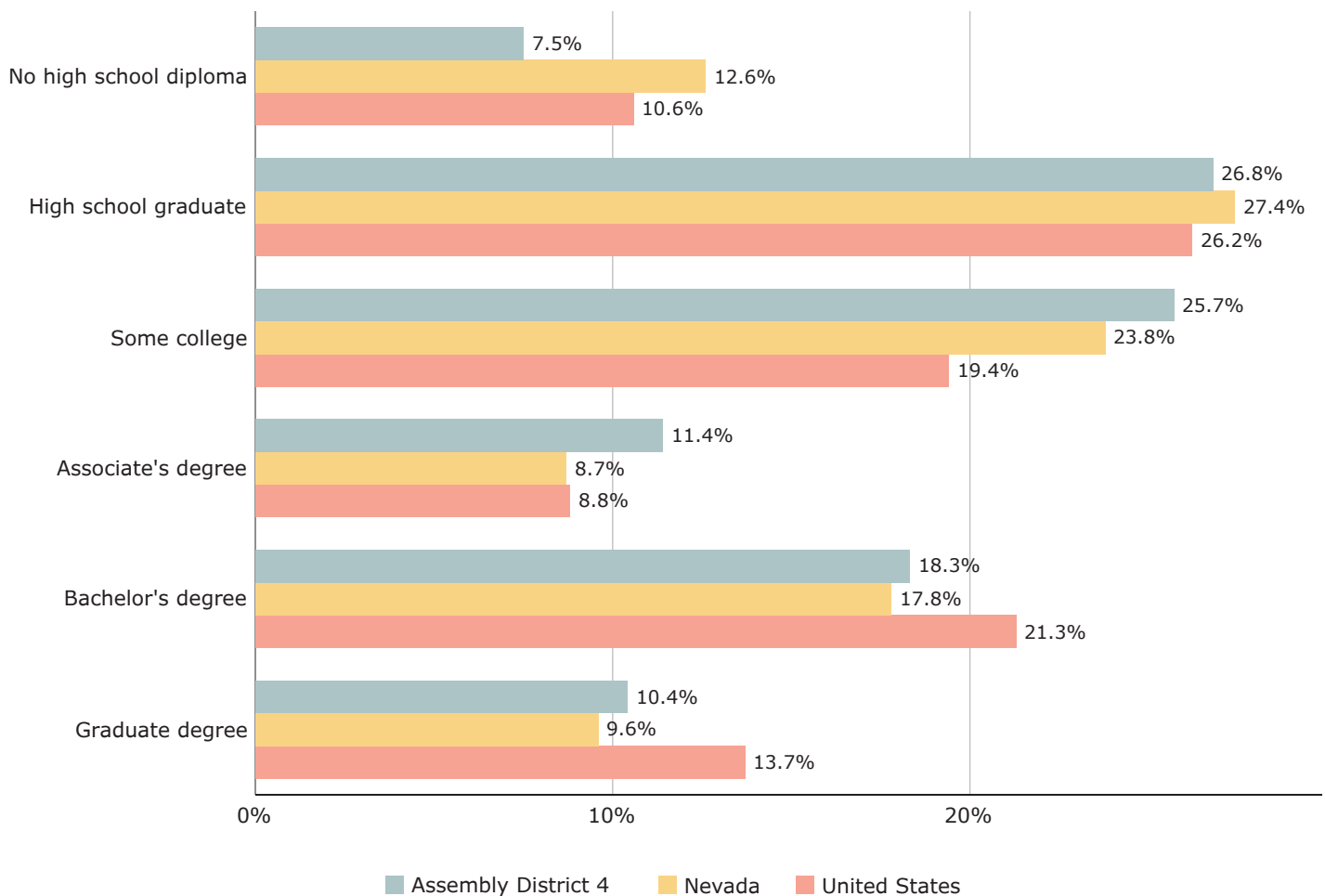

Chart 24—Percent Uninsured

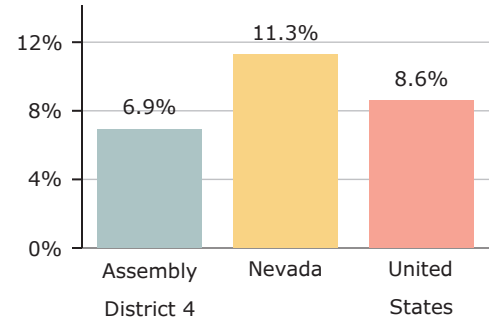
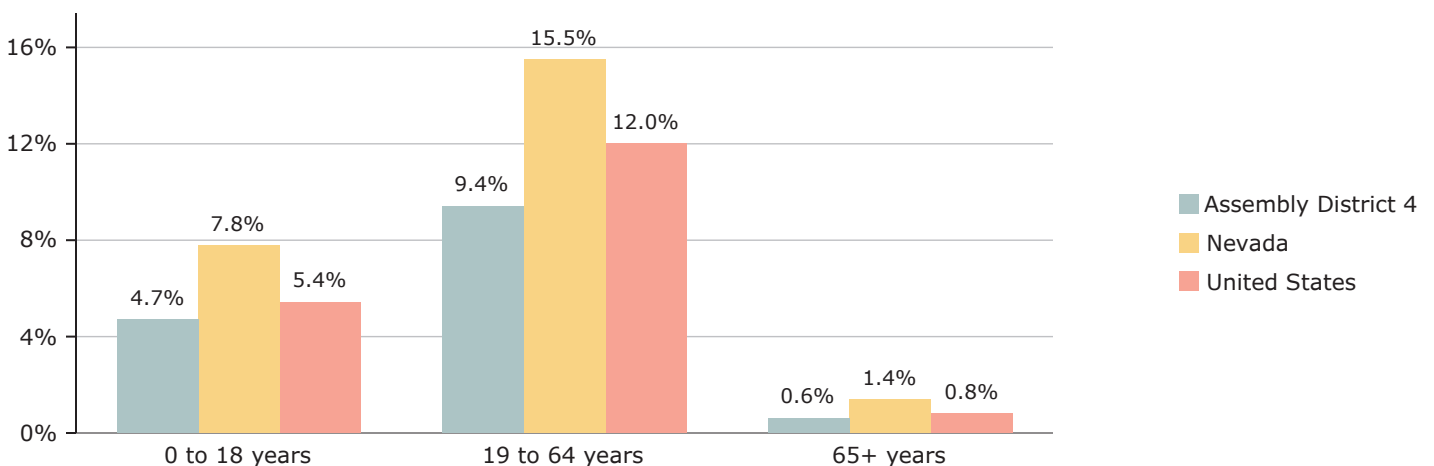

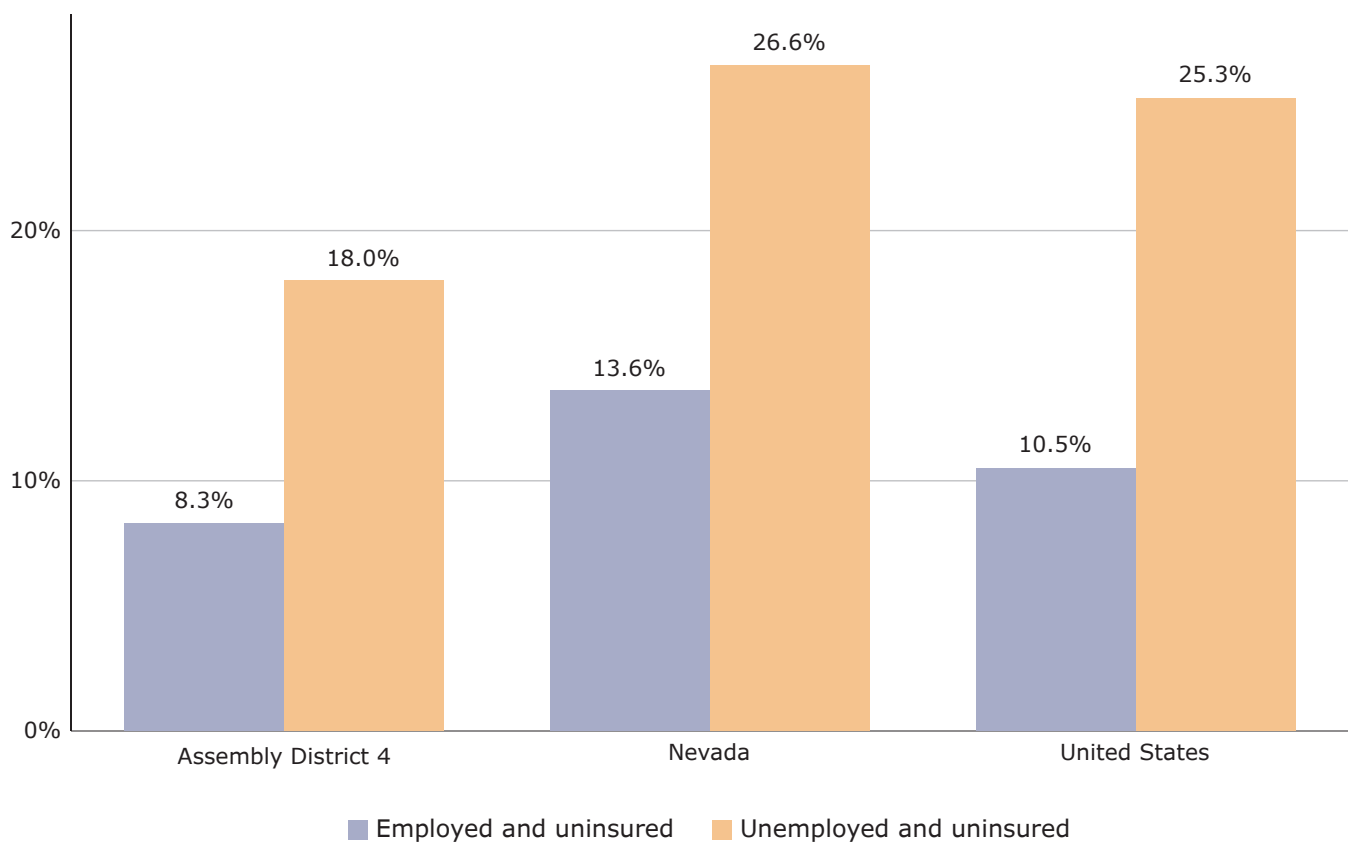

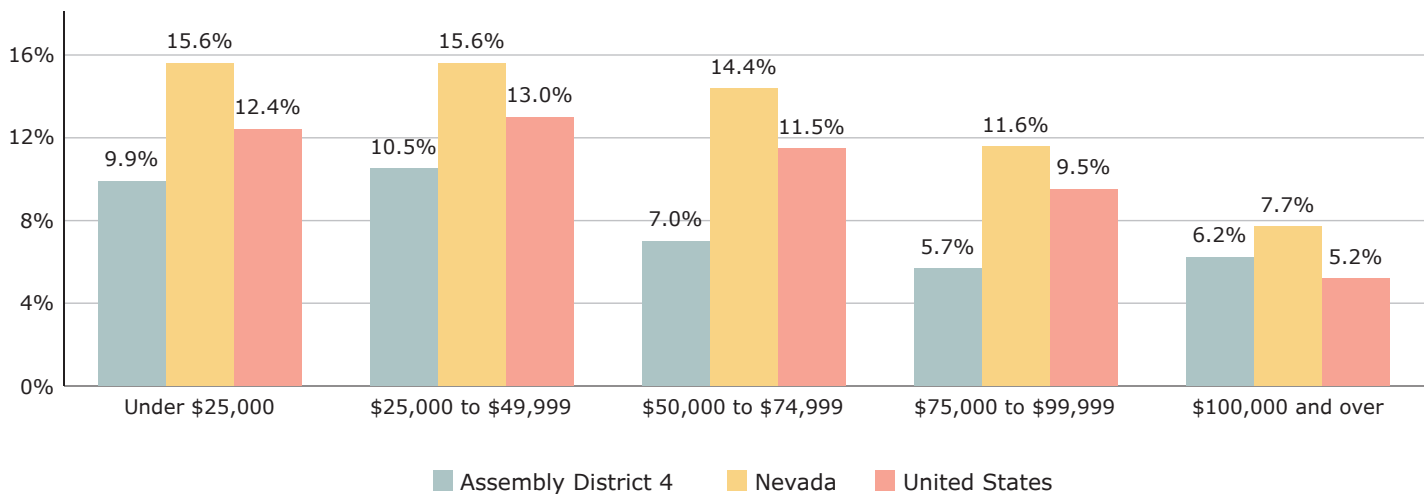

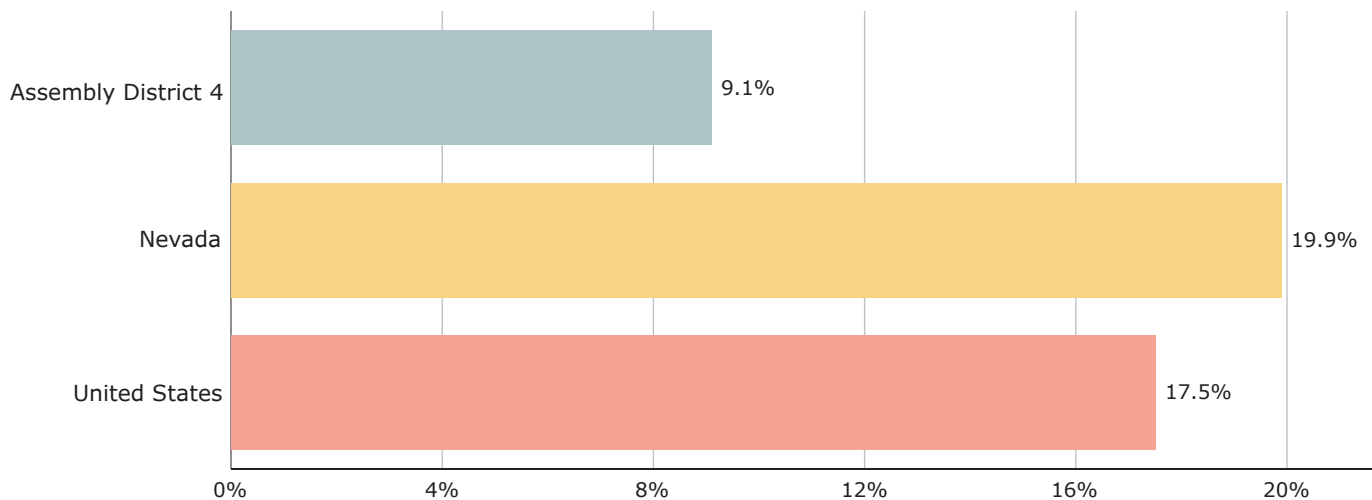

Chart 29—Home Occupancy

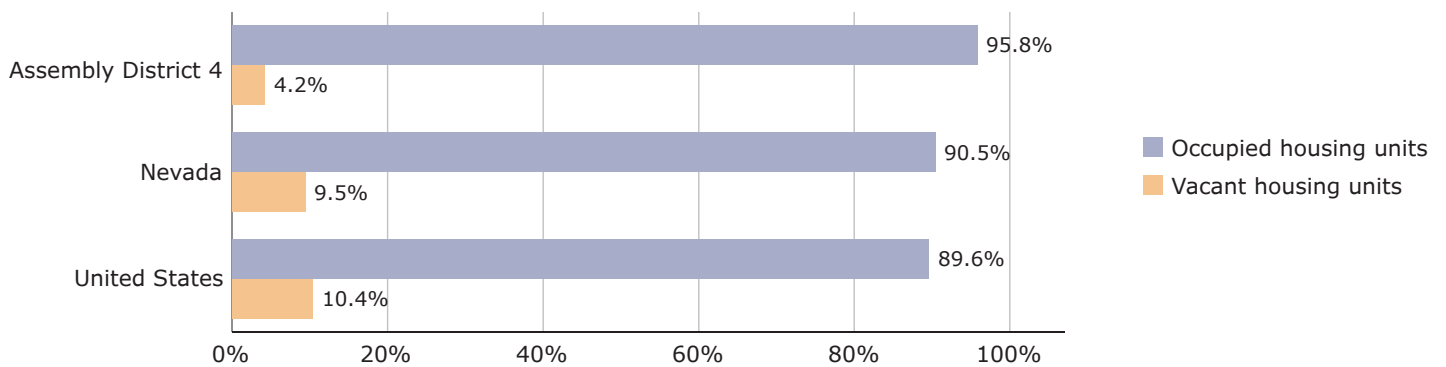
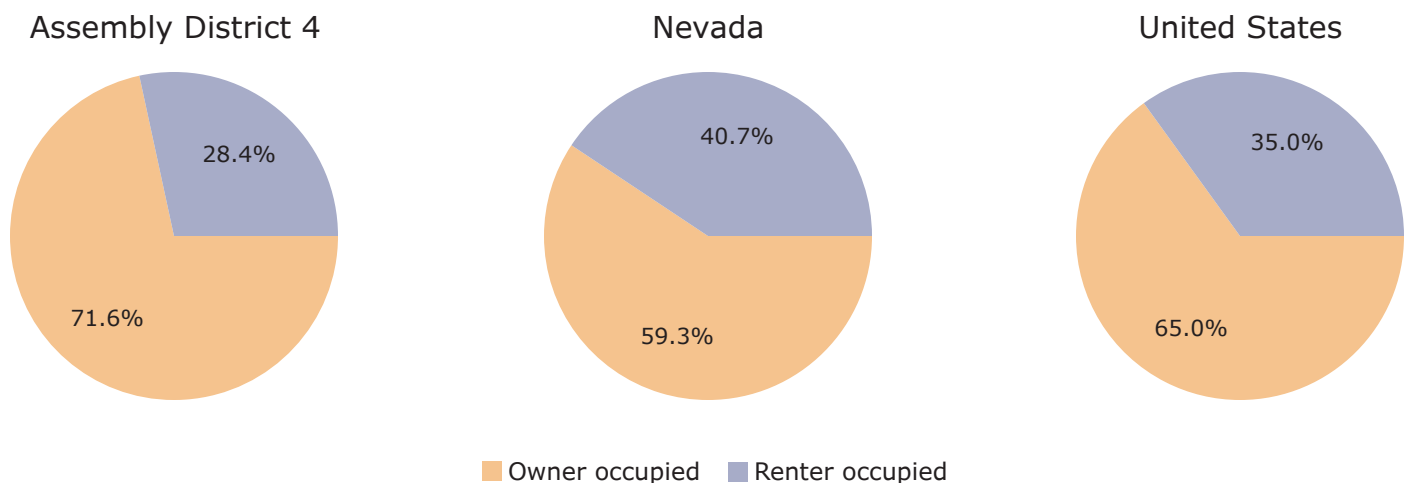


Chart 30—Tenancy of Occupied Housing Units

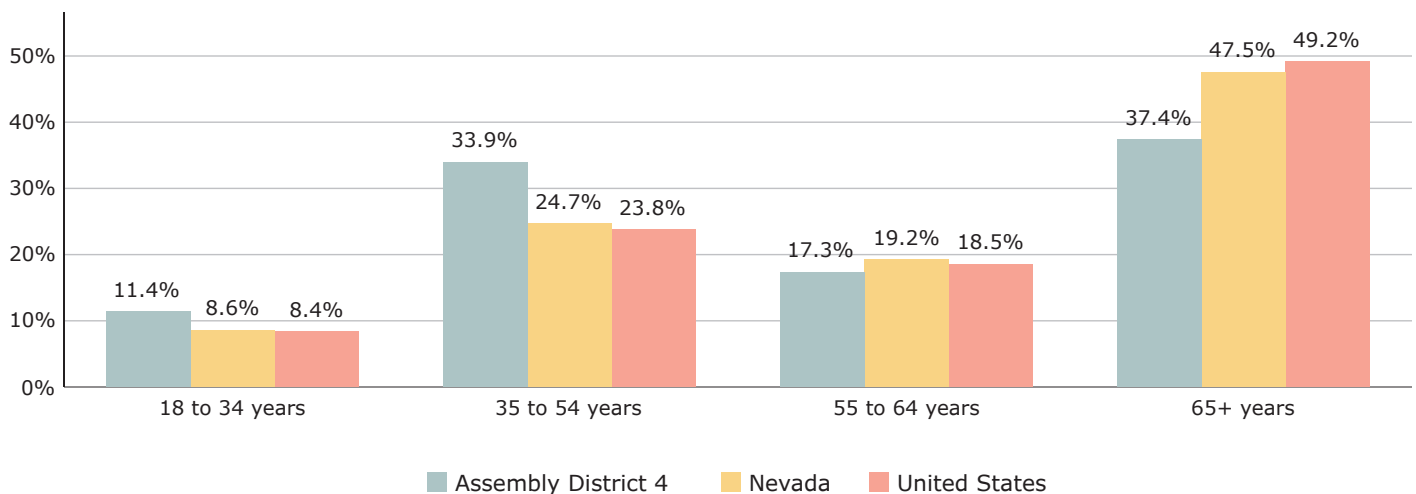

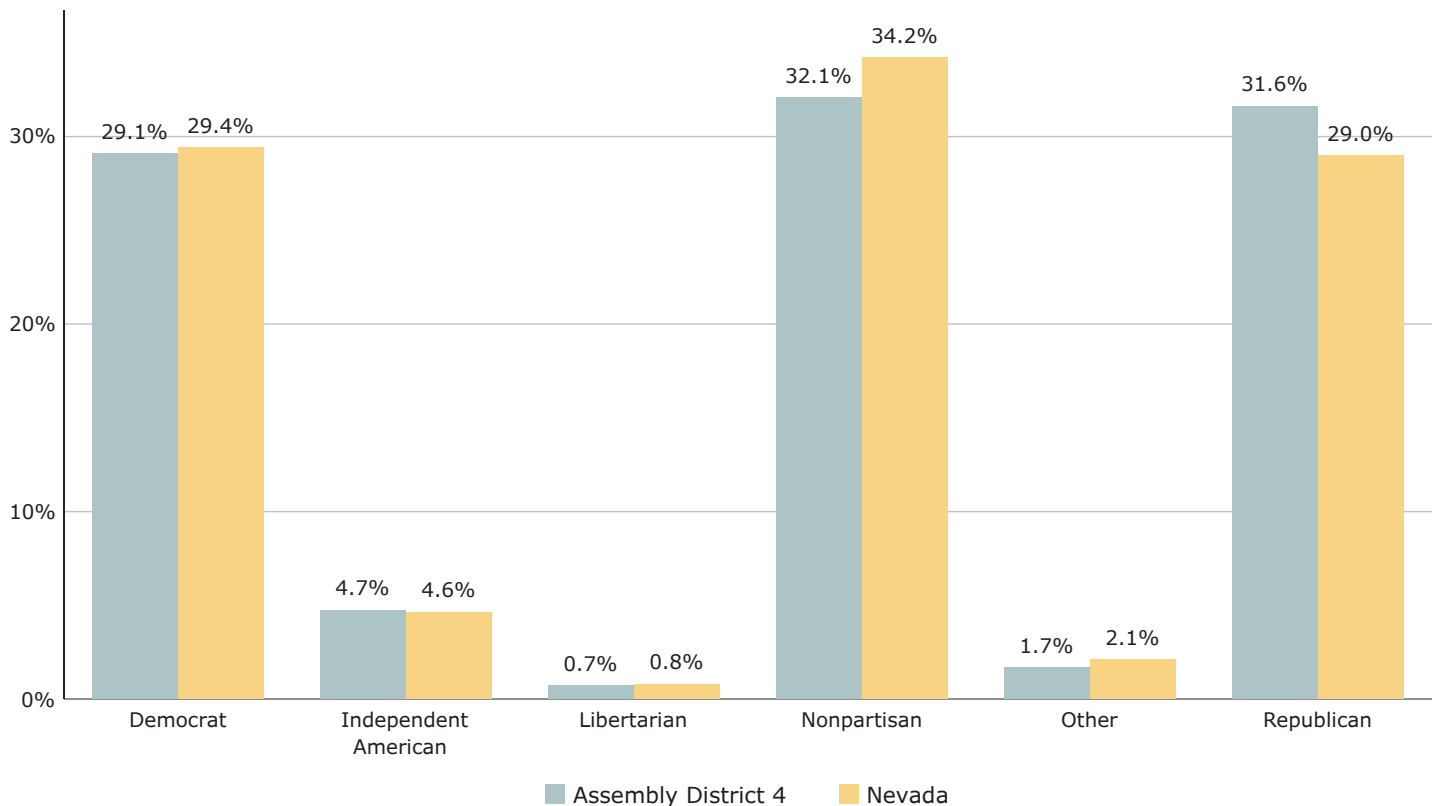

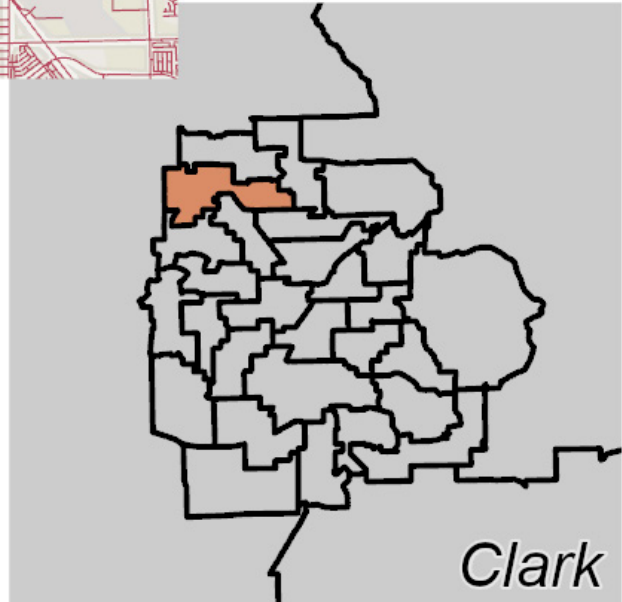
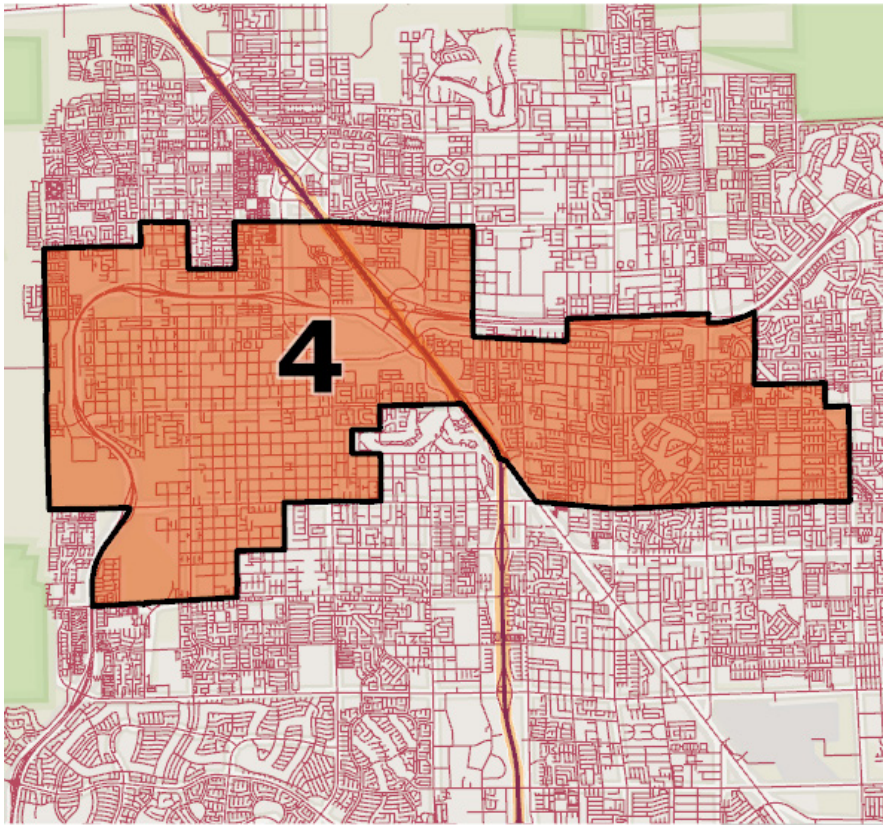
